ACTION TAKEN REPORT (2018-19)

The college Principal, Vice-Principal, Head of the Departments, Librarian, Health Supervisor constitute the Feedback review committee. The committee reviews all the feedbacks from different stake holders like students, parents, alumni, staff and employers to analyse the students development and the grievances each of the stake holders have about the institution and facilities provided by the institution. The college aims at gathering the feedback from all the above said stakeholders and make required changes in the administration, academics, sports, infrastructure as per the feedback report.

The Feedback review committee gathers and first analyses the feedbacks and checks the major concerns from the stakeholders that should be corrected with immediate affect and the changes that are to be initiated and will show their effect in long term. However corrective actions are taken after conducting a meeting with all staff and feedback review committee at the end of academic year.

S.No	Feedback Received	Action Taken
1	Books available in the college	Required number of books are always verified and purchased at the beginning of each semester as per requirement.
2	Introduction of new add-on courses	New add-on courses are introduced to acquaint students of all groups with knowledge apart from their subjects.

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ACTION TAKEN REPORT (2019-20)

Parent- Teacher meeting called as "Impact Program" is conducted every second Saturday to meet the parents and know hoe glad they are about the development of their ward after joining the college and their concerns if any about the college. The alumni students are invited by the class teachers to come and share their experience after completing their graduation. The feedback of alumni is collected to know the changes to be made in the college to meet the requirement of the industry and post graduate courses. The Principal, Vice Principal, Head of the departments, IQAC Co-ordinator and all staff members conduct meetings to incorporate the changes for the betterment of students.

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ACTION TAKEN REPORT (2020-21)

The results of the college in certain subjects like mathematics, chemistry were proportionately less compared to other subjects. The principal, IQAC coordinator identified this and also found the concern of parents and certain students regarding results in some subjects. A meeting was convened with faculty of all departments and Head of the departments to identify the slow learners in the subjects and take special care of such students and to keep record of the topics covered, the attendance, the marks of special test conducted for slow learners so that the students become on par with other students of the class. 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ACTION TAKEN REPORT (2022-23)

The Principal, Vice principal, IQAC coordinator, and Heads of the departments identified the major concern as PG coaching to be provided for the final year students to help them get into good universities for post-graduation. 1	Library	Some reference books specified by the faculty and students shall be procured by the college after approval from head office.
2	Optional Courses/ Projects	The final year students need to select either optional papers or projects. As per faculty and alumni suggestions in feedback, the projects should be chosen or separately conducted for final years.
3	Concentration on PG in University	The students should be encouraged to select any two PG course options in second year itself and shall be guided to prepare all subjects till their final semesters for better PG entrance results.
4	Internships	The faculty shall instruct faculty to encourage students to join NPTEL Swayam, UPGRAD Data Science courses for better knowledge gain.

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
